INTRODUCTION

“Hey. Have you got a moment?”

At the start of 2020, very few of us could have known how much we’d miss these six words one day. Communicating with our team members was as simple as walking over to their desks and chatting. You could ask someone to come over to your computer to look at something, brainstorm together, and exchange ideas face-to-face.

Many of these simple communication conventions were lost when the pandemic arrived.

Anyone who could work from home did so and most professionals had to get used to virtual meetings. Instead of catching someone on their way past your desk, we sent texts, emails, or instant messages.

People started talking about video conferencing or “Zoom” fatigue – the exhaustion they felt after too many video calls. Excessive close-up eye contact, constantly seeing our own faces, moving less, and using more brainpower during calls than in normal conversations added to the fatigue.¹

CHALLENGE 5

TOO MUCH TIME WASTED



PROBLEM

Most professionals now know how to participate in video meetings. But if it takes too much time to resolve hardware or software issues, for instance, it can completely derail a meeting. Not wasting time is, of course, critical. An Asana survey of more than 10,000 professionals found that 40% were spending more time on video calls in 2022 than in 2021.¹⁰

Efforts to address the fatigue and frustration of online meetings have made 15-minute meetings attractive once more.¹¹ But repeated hardware and software challenges make this approach unfeasible for most.

The same goes for sharing documents and collaborating – a process that must run smoothly to keep meetings efficient.
